

# Do you support with children with language disorder?

Children with suspected or diagnosed Developmental Language Disorder (DLD) are invited to participate in **free, virtual studies** to figure out what goals SLPs should target and what strategies work best to improve academics and language.

## Tell me more about DLD

Language characterized by:  
Leaving out or making errors with the little parts of language:

- prepositions
- pronouns
- am/is/are

Difficulty with

- correct word order
- telling coherent stories
- following directions
- learning new vocabulary
- word finding
- phonological awareness

Children with DLD often have a diagnosis of ADHD, dyslexia, learning disability, or behavior disorder.

DLD is often undiagnosed - children receiving MTSS or Tier 2 supports may also be eligible.

## Would my clients be eligible?

We screen children who:

- Are between 4-9 years old
- Have suspected difficulty with language learning
- Primarily speak & hear English
- Do **not** have a formal diagnosis of autism, intellectual disability or hearing impairment
- Have computer and internet access

**Over referrals are welcome!**

### Virtual, National, & Free

- Scheduled flexibly to accommodate family needs
- Research activities conducted by licensed, certified SLPs
- Children can continue to receive speech/ language therapy as usual

Syntax Stories  
Science Materials  
Headphones, audio recorder  
A report detailing their participation
